Daily reflection:

(Vincentian Christmas Novena, first prophecy)

Every Advent, the Vincentian Fathers & Brothers and the Daughters of Charity, among others, celebrate with a sung evening prayer, the Christmas Novena. It contains a number of Old Testament prophecies. In these we hear:

"Rejoice, O daughter of Zion! And be happy daughter of Jerusalem..."

"Be glad for the Lord will appear, and your Lord cannot deceive. If it should seem that he is late, then wait for Him. For he shall come when he is sure that you are ready."

Daily decision for action...

Sometimes it seems that the wait is endless. We're supposed to be joyful, but when is the Lord going to appear? How can we be sure that we are ready?

We're told to get ready by making a place in our hearts. Maybe, if there is a place in our hearts, the Lord has already appeared to us! Maybe the Lord appeared in someone we met yesterday. Maybe the Lord will appear in someone we stop to help today. Prepare. Make a place. Rejoice!
